Good scissors

Acrylic Paints and brushes

White Elmers Glue or Any brand Acid Free Glue

Paint brushes

Decorative papers, old books and cardboards

Found objects i.e. buttons, beads, tacks etc.

\*Exacto knife, #11 Blades

\*8" by 10" Cutting mat

Golden Matte Medium (See photo to the right.)

Cup to hold water

Metallic and Regular Paint pens (optional)
